WARNINGS

WARNING: L&H electric branders and dehorners are equipped with heavy duty three wire grounded cords. An adequate ground is required for safe operation of this unit for both humans and animals.

- Use only a heavy duty three wire grounded extension cord connected to a three wire grounded electricity source. The iron simply will not work properly if the extension cord is improperly sized too small. For recommended gauge cord, see chart below.
- Never submerge iron in sand, dirt or other substance. This will cause it to overheat and shorten its life.
- Use only, where conditions are dry. Do not stand or allow animal to stand in water or mud.
- Check before each use for cracks or breaks in the sheathing of the iron's heating element and electrical cord. If cracks or breaks are visible do not use iron. Return it to the factory for inspection and repair.
- If it appears the iron has transmitted a shock, stop using it and return to factory for inspection and repair.

ELECTRIC BRANDER

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Clipping excess hair is advisable when hair is long.
- Allow at least 90 seconds for brander to reach correct branding temperature.
- Apply brand with moderate pressure to animal and hold until skin turns dark copper color, approximately 10 seconds.
- Application time will vary with wind and weather conditions, thickness of hair, and age and breed of animal. After branding several animals, you will learn proper application time.
- If brand is not clear upon first application, it may be reapplied.
- If brand is not clear or burnt hair builds up on iron, iron may not be hot enough. Electrical source and extension cords (if used) should be checked for proper connection and size.

ELECTRIC DEHORNER

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Allow at least 90 seconds for dehorner to reach correct temperature.
- Apply the dehorner firmly, rotating slightly to make sure hot iron circles horn hase at hair line.



- Hold until skin at base of horn turns dark copper color, approximately 7 seconds.
- Do not remove the horn button or apply medication. Horn will die, the scab and horn button will fall off in four to six weeks, leaving a smooth well healed area
- The electric dehorner can be used at any time and there will be no loss of blood or severe stress on the animal.



DO NOT PLACE ELECTRICALLY HEATED IRONS IN DIRT, SAND, ASHES OR ANY SUBSTANCE THAT WILL CAUSE IT TO OVERHEAT AND SHORTEN THE LIFE OF THE IRON.

FIRE HEATED BRANDER

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Place the irons on a wood or coal burning fire or in a propane branding iron furnace
- Clipping excess hair is advisable when hair is long.



- Apply brand with moderate pressure to animal and hold until skin turns dark copper color, approximately 10 seconds.
- Application time will vary with wind and weather conditions, thickness of hair, and age and breed of animal. After branding several animals, you will learn proper application time.
- If brand is not clear upon first application, it may be reapplied.

BRASS IRONS

- Rust resistant non-corrosive copper alloy is used for its heat holding capacity. (Irons will remain a copper color when hot.)
- Not recommended for use in propane furnaces.

STAINLESS STEEL IRONS

Designed for use in a propane furnace. Stainless steel will not rust or corrode.
